Moslem's heart beat, or demons demands?

Here are some photos, below, for London depicting Muslim activists showing off their heart motives:

Think about this: **Can a Muslim be a loyal patriotic American citizen, or is "Muslim-American" an Oxymoron?**

• **Theologically?** NO. His allegiance is to Allah, the moon god of Arabia.

• **Religiously?** NO. No other religion is accepted by his Allah except Islam (2:256)

• **Socially?** NO. His allegiance to Islam forbids him to make friends with Christians or Jews.

• **Politically?** NO. He must submit to the mullah's (spiritual leaders), who teach annihilation of Israel, and the destruction of America, the great Satan.

• **Domestically?** NO. He is instructed to marry four women, and beat and scourge a wife who disobeys him.

• **Intellectually?** NO. He cannot accept the American Constitution, since it is based on Biblical principals, and he believes the Bible to be corrupt.

• **Philosophically?** NO. Islam, Muhammad, and the Koran do not allow freedom of religion and expression.

Democracy and Islam cannot co-exist. Every Muslim government is a Theocracy - either dictatorial, or autocratic. (This is not a criticism of Islam, but rather shows the tenants of orthodox Islam, and what the scholars are taught daily in the mosques.)

• **Can we co-exist even secularly? NO!**

Pentecost - the next major feast after passover **So what does it mean to us Christians?**

PENTECOST or Shavuot, one of the 7 biblical festivals

The 8 day Feast of Weeks, begins on June 2, 2006. This feast is between 2 festivals of Tabernacles, Passover (Easter) and Succoth (Feast of Tabernacles). In Hebrew it is called **Shavuot** and in Greek, it is called **Pentecost**. (See Leviticus 23:15-16).

History: Fifty days after the Spring festivals, the Israelites were to observe 'Pentecost.' They were required to bring in samples of the late spring harvest to the early 'ingathering' celebration at the Jerusalem temple. In anticipation of an even greater harvest that was to come at the end of the fall season. God gave the people **hope** and **anticipation** to see the 'first' fruit of a relationship with Him. The fulfillment of the Feast of Weeks/Pentecost, came with the birth of the body of those who are the 'first fruit of the harvest.' Jews and Gentiles who worship Yahweh in spirit and in truth, were gathered as the Lord's body, the assembly of Believers (the church) on the day of Shavuot or Pentecost. The Holy Spirit (Ruach haKodesh) came upon those first followers of Messiah (Jesus) as reported in Acts 2, and early 'harvest' of 3,000 people came to faith.

So what does this mean for today?

- 1) We can pray for both Jew and Gentile to come to faith in the Messiah (Jesus as Lord).
- 2) That the Lord will continue to pour out His Spirit on all fresh as He did at Pentecost.
- 3) We can pray that our lives will be fruitful as we spread the Good News.

Be blessed in His Glory! *The Lord Bless and keep you all.* Our love to you – In Him.
